

VIDEO REVIEW: BEST PRACTICES

5 tips to find video faster
and investigate reported incidents in record time.

ASK DRIVERS TO MARK THE VIDEO

Instead of reviewing video for hours, install an alarm button in the driver console. When an incident occurs on the bus, drivers can push the button to mark the video for later review.



USE VEHICLE TELEMETRY

Add a GPS receiver to track vehicle speed, location, and directions. Your video review software should also incorporate vehicle signals: stop-arm deployment, turn signals, and brakes.

DOWNLOAD VIDEO AUTOMATICALLY

Make sure you have wireless access to your video and have marked events download automatically as the bus returns to the yard.
